New Thompson Lane Connector service to begin *Special service launch event with Mayor Barry on Tuesday, April 4*

NASHVILLE – Customers living in South Nashville between the 100 Oaks and Murfreesboro Pike areas will now have a cross-town route providing direct service along Thompson Lane.

On Tuesday, April 4, the Nashville MTA will partner with Nashville Mayor Megan Barry and the Metro Council to kick off the new service with a short program at Coleman Park Community Center, located at the intersection of Nolensville Pike and Thompson Lane, at 10:30 a.m. There, Mayor Barry, Nashville MTA Board Chair Gail Carr Williams, and Nashville MTA CEO Steve Bland will greet transit riders and speak about the nMotion improvements coming to Nashville's public transit in the future.
